Dear Local Businesses & Friends:

Every October the First United Methodist Church of Owasso hosts their annual award-winning Pumpkin Patch for Missions. One of the weekend events is the Run for the Patch -which includes a 5K, 10K, and 15K, all USATF certified courses with chip timing and a Fun Run. This annual event will be held on October 14, 2017 in memory of Hance Henrie, a special community member who always enjoyed working at the patch and running to help raise mission funds. Hance, 20 years old, was tragically killed in May of 2011 in an automobile accident caused by a drunk driver. **Proceeds from the Hance Henrie Memorial Run for the Patch will be used to fund Pumpkin Patch mission projects, MADD (Mothers Against Drunk Driving), LifeShare and the Hance Henrie memorial fund.** Some of the mission projects The Pumpkin Patch has supported in the past include: Meals on Wheels, Owasso Community Resources, Youth Force, Christmas Everyday, Food Pantry, Imagine No Malaria and many more. The Hance Henrie memorial fund has been used to construct a permanent memorial path to remember Hance near the pumpkin patch. This path includes outdoor fitness stations that the community can enjoy.
